"Refugee Resettlement Committee"!

- Council members discussed local
homelessness issues in the community and a
close connection to drug abuse as outlined by
Nick Versteeg's documentary. Farther
enquiries into the issues may occur if
opportunities develop.

- Affie reported that Kingdom Treasures has a strong demand for more child care and a "waiting list".
- Pastor Kevin and Elder Norm B reported on good connections and conversations at the meetings of Classis BCNW. The MINUTES of those meetings have been posted on the website of Classis BCNW.
- Uses of the church sanctuary following Sunday worship services was reviewed. It was generally agreed that people using the space need to keep in mind to not interfere with others that are also in the space – minimize or shorten excess noise, keep feet on the floor -don't start athletic competitions (Save those for later in the day?)
