continues to offer a **4 to 1 donation match**.

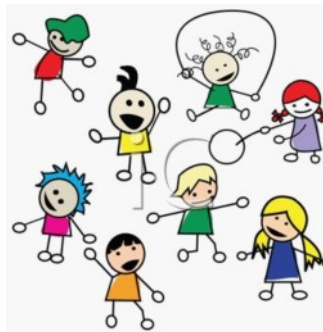


Safe Church Training Workshop
