World Renew

Cyclone Idai destroyed homes and devastated crops, infrastructure and livelihoods throughout southern Africa. World Renew is responding.



This storm exacerbated the humanitarian needs caused by flooding throughout Malawi, Mozambique and Zimbabwe that has affected families since the beginning of March. Having lost homes and possessions, many families are sleeping on the ground with no protection from the elements.

World Renew has a long history of community development and disaster response work in the region. Through years of work, World Renew has developed a strong network of local church and community-based partners who are ready to help families affected by Cyclone Idai.

Plans are already in place to provide families with blankets to stay warm and tarps to build temporary shelters until their homes are repaired. Families will also receive kitchen kits to replace the household possessions they lost.
