Is coming alongside parents and young children in their journey to better health. In remote areas of developing countries, many parents—including pregnant mothers—lack the resources that they and their young children need to survive and thrive. Without proper care from a doctor, nurse, or midwife, pregnant women are at risk of serious, even fatal complications. Without proper nutrition, young children are at risk of stunted growth, disease, and death. For many families, such challenges can make good health seem impossible. But there is good news to celebrate. Families are being equipped to improve health for mothers and young children. There are programs in agriculture, health, nutrition, and literacy, and more that connect parents to opportunities to overcome poverty and achieve good health for the long-term. These programs are carried out through Christian partners dedicated to sharing the good news of Christ through holistic, faith-based approaches that nurture a person's relationship with God in connection to their development. As our partners carry out programs, they do so for Christ and because of Christ, uniting word and deed so that more people can flourish.
