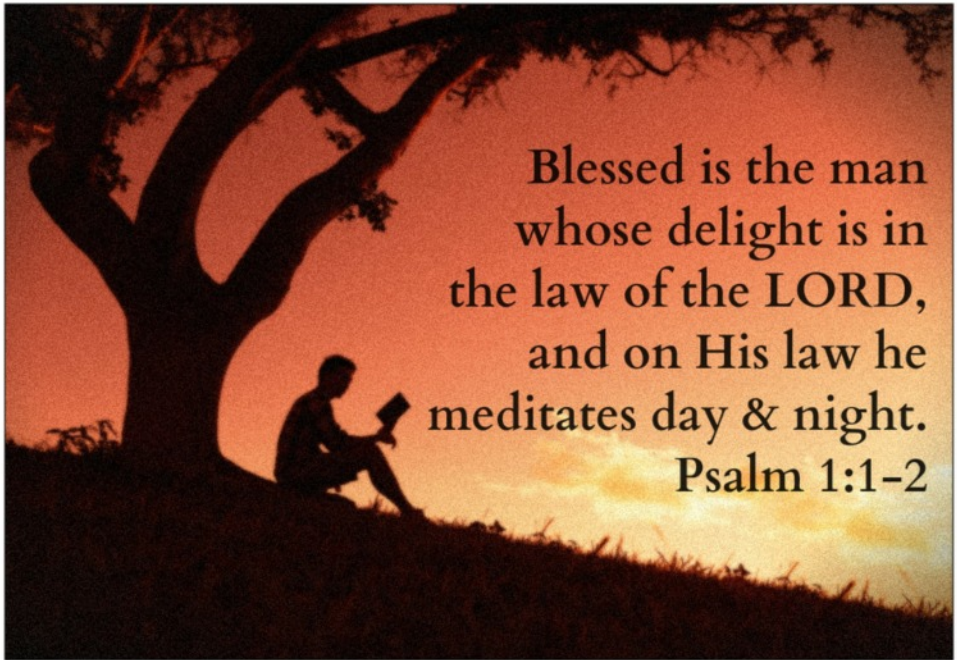

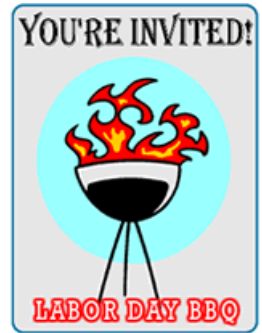
Service at Sunridge Today
