Guidelines for Attending a Sunday Service

1. Do not come if you are sick with anything contagious (even a cold, etc), are required to self isolate or have been in contact with someone who has COVID-19.
2. We'd like to use the outside front entrance area for socializing after the service, so for those that can, please park away from the front entrance (by Campbell Street) or if you prefer, in the back parking lot. If you have mobility issues you can still park in the front handicap areas.
3. We will sign you in when you arrive. There is hand sanitizer available and also masks if you would like one.
4. There is also quick drying hand sanitizer by the bathroom for spraying bathroom faucets, doorknobs, handles, etc. after each use. Only use the bathrooms by the Office.
5. Maintain physical distancing of 6 feet (also stay apart when socializing outside).
6. There will be no congregational singing at this time though there will be worship music projected throughout the Service.
7. The Library is closed - come during the week when the Office is open.
8. There is no Nursery though you can use the Fireside Room for childcare if needed (the Daycare side of the church is not available).
9. There is no Sunday School.
10. There is no coffee and socializing is in the front parking lot.
11. Sit apart from others in the Sanctuary (family groups can stay together).
12. We will celebrate Lord's Supper and you can pick up the wafer and juice package before you enter the Sanctuary.
13. Offerings can be dropped off in a box at the back of the Sanctuary as you enter or exit the Sanctuary.

Interested in an Elim Seniors Village in Greater Victoria?

At present, there is a faith-based Senior's complex for independent, assisted living and extended care in Surrey and now in Chilliwack. A small group of individuals living in greater Victoria is spearheading a project to bring an Elim Village to the greater Victoria area. A public information meeting is planned for Victoria some time in September. Due to COVID restrictions a maximum of 50 people can attend so interested parties will need to register in advance. History of Elim Victoria

The interest in having Elim on the Island started with a small group of people from the greater Victoria area. This led to initial meetings with Elim representatives, then with an interested local developer and finally consultations with the municipal representatives. The Elim Board has committed \$250,000 toward this project with the understanding that every local effort will be made to match that amount for the due diligence work. Elim is currently working with two local planning and development consultants. To date there has been one information meeting in July. There was a good response and approx. \$105,000 has been received toward the due diligence process.
