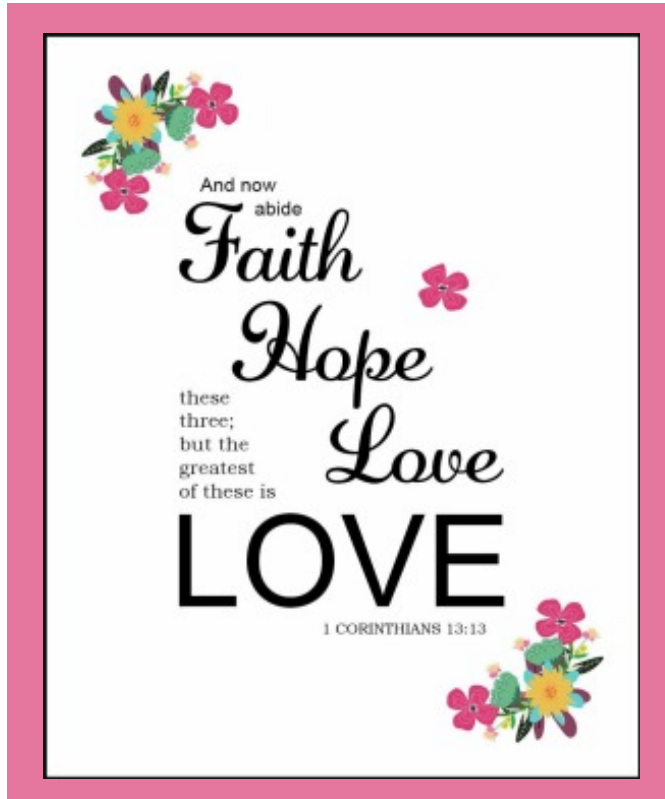

COUNCIL REPORT – Monday, February 8, 2021

- The church's FULL Council met virtually on Monday, using Google Meet. Pastor Kevin opened the meeting with devotions (dealing with God's spiritual blessings, redemption and forgiveness), Bible reading and prayer.
 - Pastor Kevin reported that his February 4 "Defense of dissertation" was successful and Council congratulates him with completion of this step in his theological studies.
 - Council accepted a membership request for Calvin and Lindsay D and their children: William and Jacob to become members of Duncan CRC. Although we cannot yet meet together on Sundays or other times "Welcome to our fellowship!"
 - Henrietta G has agreed to serve as one of the "Board members" of Kingdom Treasures pre-school. Council approved that appointment and we pray that the Lord will bless your involvement with that church ministry.
 - Financial reports for the church's 2020 financial year have been prepared, but not all council members could get their copies yet, so approval for distribution of the report will be delayed.
 - Church accounts now have enough funds to upgrade/replace some of the main components of the church's "Sound system/Livestreaming" and work of purchase and installation is expected to begin soon.
 - Delegates were appointed for the March 2, 3, 2021 meetings of Classis BCNW, which will be held as "zoom" meetings. Pastor Kevin VanderVeen, Elder Delegate: Bill W, Alternate: `Renee dB.
 - Tentative approval was given for one-half of a "COVID-safe" grad ceremony/celebration for DCS Secondary grads at the church June 28,29.
- Next meeting of the Full Council is scheduled for March 8.
