

You can also give your offerings through Interac ETransfer from your bank online. Log in to your bank's online banking and navigate to the Send Interac e-Transfer area. Your first time using this method you will need to add giving@duncancrc.org as a new recipient. (You can leave the mobile phone number blank, and if it asks for a security question you can make up anything - we are set up for auto-deposit so the security question will not be used). To designate a portion of your offering to a specific cause, note the amount for that cause in the note with your transfer. Any undesignated funds will go to Church Ministries.

Dear friends in Christ,

Council hopes and prays that everyone is continuing to do as well as can expected in this covid situation. We continue to hope and pray that positive changes are on the horizon over the next few months. It is also the time of year that we are approaching members to serve as elders and deacons in council. Having shared these thoughts with you, it is council's hope and prayer that those who are approached will thoughtfully and prayerfully consider this call, not from the church, but from God, to be a part of reviving and rebuilding our church in the Valley.
