COUNCIL REPORT – Monday, April 12, 2021

- The church's FULL Council met virtually on Monday, using Google Meet. The Auction starts at 7:00 pm on Thursday, April 22 and goes all weekend until 7:00 pm on Monday, April 26.


The Auction will goLIVE at 6:00 pm on Mon. April 26 and could go for hours as...
