

Church Ministries and (YFC Youth Unlimited Blue Bus Mobile Outreach)

Mobile Outreach launched in May of 1998. Today staff drive a customized bus to Esquimalt, Quw'utsun, Tsawout and Tseycum Nations where they run weekly programs for youth ages 8-18. Area churches pray, provide financial support and send volunteer leaders who help run the weekly programs that include a God Talk, nutritious snacks, games, crafts, sports and bus trips. These programs are only possible because Indigenous community leaders keep their doors open, and community staff and youth continue to ask for the Blue Bus team to return each week.
