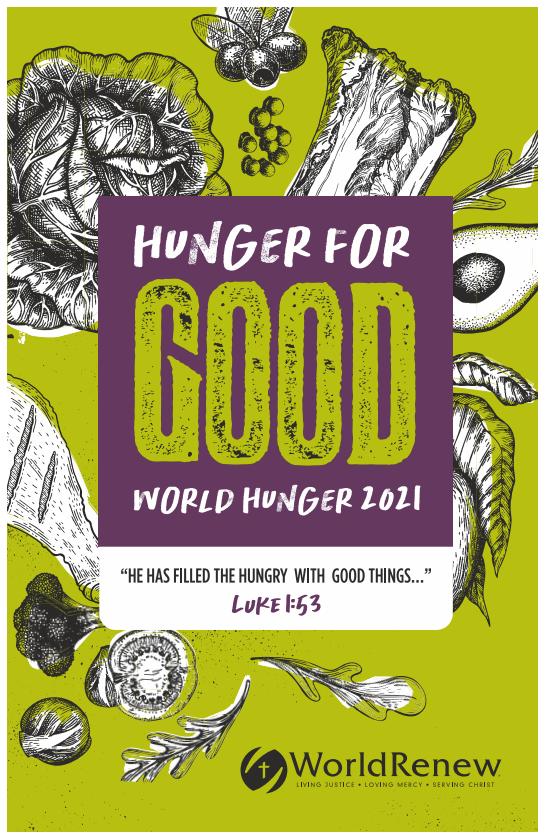

NOTE: It’s important to stay home if you or anyone in your household is feeling sick.

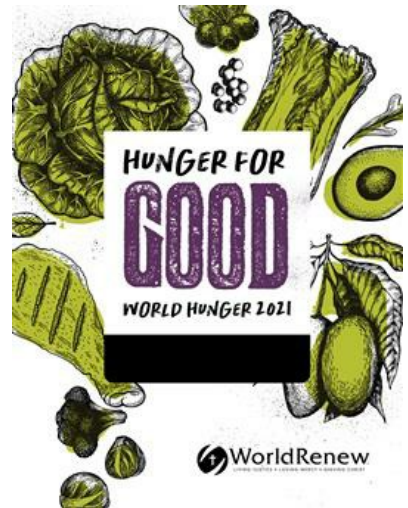
The services will continue to be live-streamed at 10 am and then available as recordings afterwards.
