COUNCIL REPORT – Monday, May 9, 2022

- The church's FULL Council met in the church Council meeting room on Monday. For opening devotions, we discussed with Pastor Dan several verses of I Corinthians 10: 31 -33, where we are encouraged to do all things (from basics like eating and drinking – to more complex like teaching and leading) – doing those things to the honor and glory of God.

- The required annual reports for a charitable organization to the BC Registrar and Canada Revenue Agency have been sent.

- Information, pamphlets and a poster have been received encouraging persons to attend Inspire 2022 in Chicago, August 4-6. (Affie and John expect to attend because they'll be 1 days drive from there.)

- Council will ask worship teams/technicians to provide pre-service music in the sanctuary for most worship services.

- Affie reported that meals at the first of the church's community dinners were well-received – after a 2-year stoppage.

- Stewards Ministry members will be seeking help with understanding financial issues/limits that may apply to their ministry.

- It was generally agreed that the Congregational meeting benefited well from pre-

printed/distributed ministry reports and more frequent times for specific prayers.

- Kingdom Treasures is seeking a church member to serve on the board of that society for monthly board meetings. Contact Danielle D if you can help.

- It is expected that nominees for council positions will be announced on May 29.

It began in 1939 with a three-fold mission: Proclaim that Jesus Christ is Lord, Help followers of Jesus grow in their faith, Strengthen the church.



1. **Today** is a daily devotional that you can get in print, on the web, as a mobile app, or via email.

2. Kid's Corner is a website that helps kids find their place in God's story.

3. **Family Fire** is an online community exploring what it means to be Holy Spirit led in our families, dating, marriages, sexuality, parenting, and in-law relationships. Our team of therapists, pastors, and writers stoke the Spirit's flame through live retreat events and encouragement on the web, social media, and email.

4. **Groundwork** is a half-hour radio program and podcast that helps you build a biblical foundation for your life. Pastors Scott Hoezee and Darrell Delaney invite listeners into conversation that digs deeply into the substance of God's Word.

5. **Think Christian** is an online magazine where Christians bridge the perceived gap between faith and culture. Thoughtful discussions explore God's sovereignty over culture and what it means to live and think as a Christian.

6 **Church Juice** is a website where church leaders can learn how to intentionally engage their congregations and communities in meaningful ways. Here you'll find free resources to help you refine your church's website, social media, branding, and marketing.
