COUNCIL REPORT – Monday, July 11, 2022

- The church's FULL Council met in the church Council meeting room on Monday. For opening devotions, we spent time with Pastor Kevin with Bible readings silences for reflection and then discussing the word of the Lord.

- Council welcomed two returning members: Will B and Sandy V and two new elected/installed members: Matt B and Dan S (in absentia). Council also thanked Frank G for his almost 6 years on council as he retires from it for a period of rest.

- Council voted to install Chris \dot{G} as chair-person and Pete K as vice-chair and they accepted the appointment to those positions.

- After some additional discussion about needed commitment and additional benefits of the program, council agreed to apply to become a participant congregation in the "Growing Young with all Generations" program from the Growing Young Cohort starting in January 2023.

- It was agreed to postpone discussion sessions about the Human Sexuality Report till the fall. Michelle and Pastor Kevin will prepare some advance questions/information to be distributed for church members to reflect on during the weeks till the next session.

- GEMS and Cadets meetings are being planned for a start on Oct. 11

- There was some good discussion time to consider details of pastoral care needs, worship services planning, Fall Congregational meeting preparations, church's 70th anniversary and further information will follow in the coming weeks.

- Deacons agreed to inform church members about financial needs for meeting the accepted budget for this year's church expenses.

Next meeting of the Full Council is scheduled for August 8, 2022.
