COUNCIL REPORT - Monday August 8, 2022

The church's FULL Council met in the church Council meeting room on Monday.

For opening devotions, Pastor Kevin highlighted Matthew 25: 34ff in light of the pastoral care we've been extending and needing to extend for our church community and beyond. Kevin expressed gratitude for how we care for the sick, the hurting and others in our church community.
