- The church's FULL Council met in the church Council meeting room on Monday. For opening devotions, we spent time with Pastor Kevin discussing some parts of Chapter 3 of the Growing Young booklet. This chapter advises church members to develop casual relationships with younger members of the congregation.
- Council reviewed and approved minutes of previous meetings, and dealt with the mail that was received (copy of the 2022 Church Order).
- Pastor Kevin and elder Dan Schultz were appointed to be delegates to the March 7, 8 meetings of Classis BCNW in Burnaby.
- Various pastoral visit needs and concerns were reviewed so that prayers of support can be raised to the Lord about confidential issues.
- Renee dB will now be attending the monthly meetings of full council to keep more fully informed for her work as the church's administrative assistant and for additional support/input of council's responsibilities and activities.
- Painting several of the rooms in the preschool wing and addition of a wall mural by Jaymie has been completed despite some water damage that needed to be dealt with when snows melted.
- Kingdom Treasures has had to cut back to shorter work days because of staffing shortages.
- Results of this past week's voting will be announced during the church service next Sunday (Jan 22).
- At the request of Classis BCNW, arrangements will be made for a meeting with "church visitors" from Victoria on Feb. 13.
