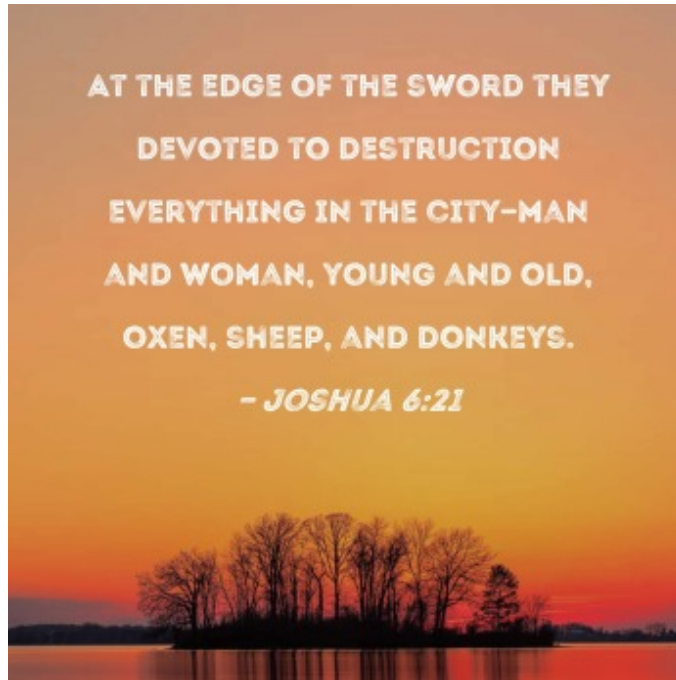

- Sandy V provided reports from the Pastoral Search Team on the Survey results, Pastor Job Description, Pastor Compensation, Church profile, Community profile and Advertisement for the position.

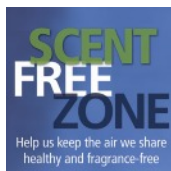
