More on Adrianna: I grew up in DeMotte, Indiana, in a Christian family. I did my undergrad in Spanish and Theology at Dordt University in Iowa and a master's in Linguistics and Exegesis at Trinity Western University in British Columbia. Opportunities at Dordt allowed me to travel to Nicaragua for a summer trip and then semester abroad, and I loved the work of the Nehemiah Center in Managua. When given the opportunity to serve as a volunteer with Resonate's Cohort Central America for a year in Nicaragua with the Nehemiah Center, I was excited to experience cross-cultural mission in a new way. I ended up staying in Nicaragua after going there in 2014 until 2023. I met my husband there, had a son, and now we are living in the United States so my husband can get US paperwork while we wait for another baby to arrive this summer.

In Nicaragua I worked with the Nehemiah Center directly for seven years facilitating intercultural partnerships between the Nehemiah Center, local churches, and North American churches. We hosted a lot of teams and also did a lot of work to keep up the relationships throughout the year. In 2021, we transitioned to the role of Connections Coach under Resonate, and we have been mentoring organizations throughout Central America on their cross-cultural partnerships. We are still able to do that work remotely while we live in the United States, but I have also taken on the role of a Local Mission Leader while we live in Sioux Falls, South Dakota.
