Food Hampers:

Thanks to the generous donations of donors and food suppliers, a nutritious food hamper is available once every 30 days to anyone who feels they are not able to purchase enough food for themselves and their family. Each hamper is specially created with up to a week's supply of food. You decide if you need a hamper, no income qualification necessary. Hamper distribution is Monday to Friday – 9:50 am to 12:30 pm. Special Saturday pickup of pre-order hampers is available for families who are unable to come during regular hamper hours. Call ahead to register and schedule a time to pick up a hamper. Call 250.746.1566. On the first visit bring a piece of Government ID for each member in the family. In addition to the monthly hamper, extra fresh vegetables, fruit and bread are available each day in the center during regular open hours.

Lunch: Cowichan Valley Basket Society invites guests to join them at the center to meet others and share some food. Thanks to the donations of generous donors, coffee and pastries are served from 8:30 am to 11 am and a nutritious lunch is served from 11 am to 3:30 pm.
