On Monday, the full sessions of Synod begin. Synod is a gathering of delegated church leaders and representatives who meet to pray, discuss, and make decisions about matters that affect the whole denomination and in the Christian Reformed Church (CRCNA), Synod is the highest governing body. Highlights include welcoming new ministers, hearing from global church partners, interviewing seminary faculty, recognizing retirements, and celebrating diversity through worship and a banquet.
