Here are some updates

1. Raúl had his US citizenship appointment a week ago. He did really well on the civics and English portions of the tests. The interview involved a lot of questions about a few particular issues that Raúl disclosed on his application. The officer was polite and courteous, seeking to understand Raúl's situation. He said he needed more time to deliberate about the case and give a response whether or not Raúl is approved for citizenship at this time.

We should hear something more within 30 days or so.

2. Mattías had some doctor appointments this week, and his kidney continues to show mild swelling, but nothing the doctor is worried about. They would like to check again in a year. If nothing has worsened, then they will consider that this shape is just part of his regular anatomy rather than something to be monitored. We praise God that all reports come back saying Mattías is healthy, developing well, and there's nothing to be concerned about.

3. We praise God that through generous financial supporters, we were able to meet our financial goal for the fiscal year that ended in June! This is the first time that has happened since we came on staff with Resonate 4 years ago. We feel affirmed in our calling and work through this, and very encouraged by all of you with your prayers, care, and gifts!

4. We leave for Canada, Lord willing, on Tuesday, July 22. Please pray for safety as we drive the ~20 hours to our family reunion and then farther north to Edmonton to visit with churches there. Again, thank you for lifting us up in your thoughts and prayers. We have been working through many different emotions, but overall we feel confident in God's care for us and grateful for the support of others around us.

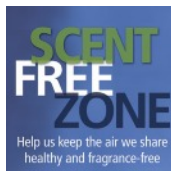
