1. Our family plans to travel to Alberta, Canada for a family reunion and 2 church visits from July 22-August 15. Please pray for traveling mercies and for good connections with family and supporters.
2. Praise the Lord, we received notification a week ago that Raúl will have his US citizenship test and interview on July 11 in Omaha, Nebraska (about 3 hours away from us). On June 30 he will go to the lawyers office for a practice interview and find out more about the process. Our understanding is that he will take a civics test where he needs to answer 6/10 questions correctly. He was given a study guide of 100 questions that the 10 questions will come from. He will also be interviewed regarding his application answers. I think this will serve as the English test also. He will be told on July 11 if he passed or not. If he passes, he will be sworn in as a US citizen. We aren't sure if the swearing in will happen on July 11 or at a later date - we have heard both scenarios in recent months.

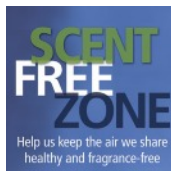
