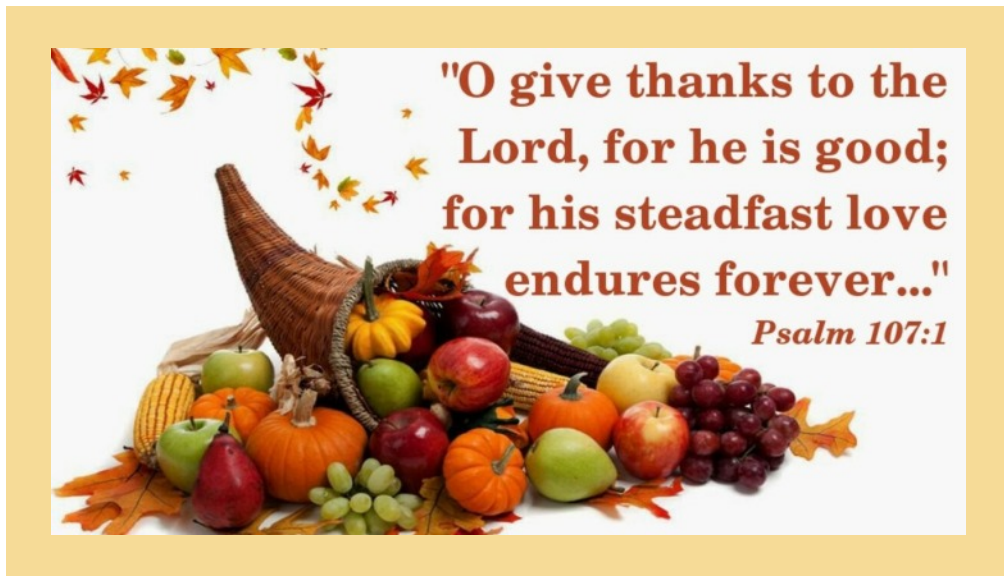

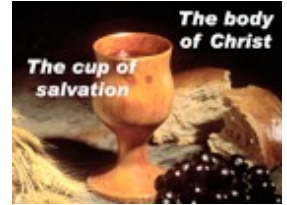
Worship Services
