The Church's FULL Council met at the Church Monday, January 5, 2026

- Shawn D led a devotion from Hebrews 13:6-8 where we have assurance for the New Year that, "Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today and tomorrow".
 - Council heard the testimonies of Ryan, Aisha and London T who are accepted for Baptism and Membership. Pastor Tom and Joyce H also shared their stories and are accepted as Associate Members so Pastor Tom can keep his Pastoring credentials.
 - On Monday, January 12, the congregation started "40 days of Scripture Reading and Prayer" for the "Thriving Essentials" program through Thrive (from CRCNA at no cost to the Church). This program helps Churches determine their Ministry focus in Missions, Discipleship, Discernment and Leadership in the next 1, 3 and 5 years. There will be an upcoming workshop on February 21 with Liz Tolkamp, a survey for the congregation, a Council retreat followed by a vision team that will continue to work with goals and plans.

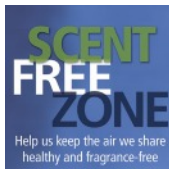
