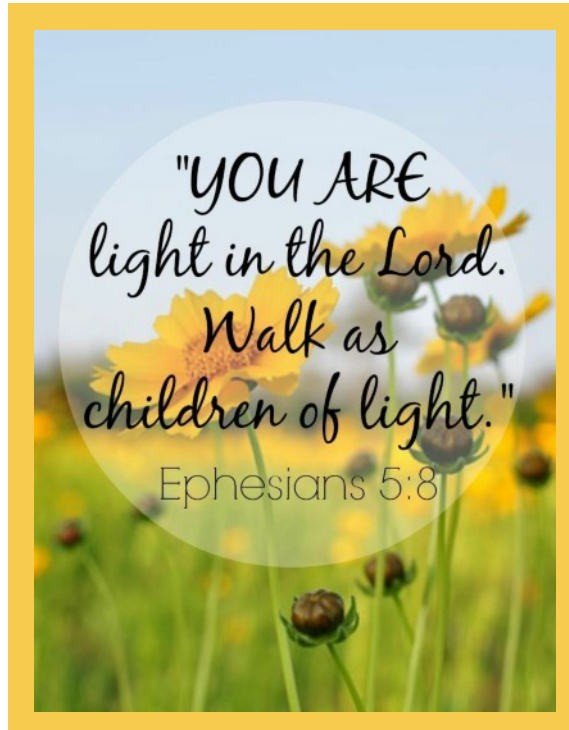

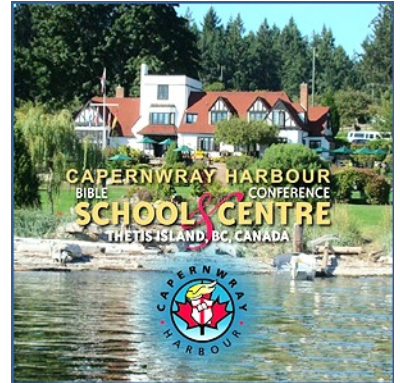
Worship Services
