#### Under the Sun - Ecclesiastes - Summer Sermon Series

This summer, our Under the Sun sermon series will journey through the book of Ecclesiastes, a wisdom book that wrestles honestly with life's biggest questions. Again and again, the Teacher observes that everything "under the sun"—the things we often pursue for meaning, success, pleasure, security, and fulfillment—is ultimately vapor: fleeting and unable to provide lasting satisfaction. Ecclesiastes challenges us to recognize the limits of what this world can offer and to consider where true life is found. As we explore its wisdom together, we will discover that genuine contentment and purpose cannot be achieved through our own efforts, but are found in God alone. While everything under the sun falls short, Jesus, the Son, offers the abundant and eternal life for which we were created.
